COMMUNITY PROFILE

Florence is the capital of Italy's Tuscany region and is noted for its culture, architecture, and monuments. It is home to many masterpieces of Renaissance art and architecture. One of its most iconic sights is the Duomo, a cathedral with a terracotta-tiled dome engineered by Brunelleschi and a bell tower by Giotto. The Galleria dell'Accademia displays Michelangelo's "David" sculpture. The Uffizi Gallery exhibits Botticelli's "The Birth of Venus" and da Vinci's "Annunciation." The city also contains numerous museums and art galleries, such as the Uffizi Gallery and the Palazzo Pitti. Florence attracts millions of tourists each year, and it plays an important role in Italian fashion.
