

Belmont Secondary School is one of three secondary schools in the School District 62 Sooke. It is strong in the sciences, music, foreign languages, and sports (American football, basketball, baseball, and rugby). The school offers dual-credit university-level courses, similar to Advanced Placement (AP), where students have the opportunity to earn credit towards university studies, as well as several academies including Baseball and Softball, Climbing, Equine, Ice Hockey, and Mountain Biking. A full range of athletics, school clubs and extracurricular activities is available for all students.
